




The Feasts of Autolycus: The Diary of a Greedy Woman

A recent researcher summed her up as quot;an adventurous, accomplished, self-assured, wellknown columnist, biographer, cookbook collector, and art criticquot;; in addition, she wrote travelogues, mainly of European cycling voyages, and memoirs, centred on her London salon. Her biographies included the first in almost a century of the proto-feminist Mary Wollstonecraft, one of her uncle the folklorist Charles Godfrey Leland, and one of her friend the painter Whistler. In recent years, her art criticism has come under scrutiny, and her food criticism has been reprinted.
