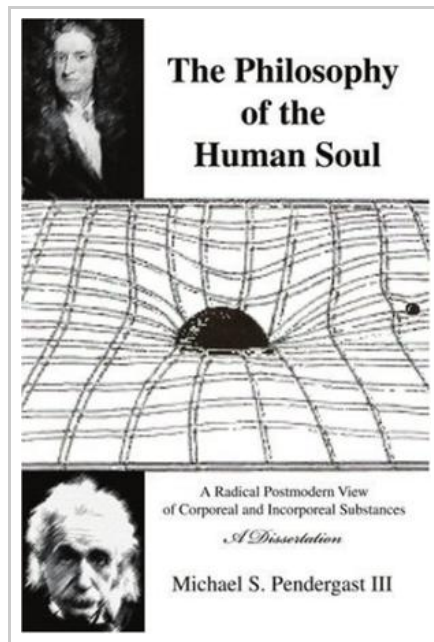




The Philosophy of the Human Soul: A Radical Postmodern View of Corporeal and Incorporeal Substances
