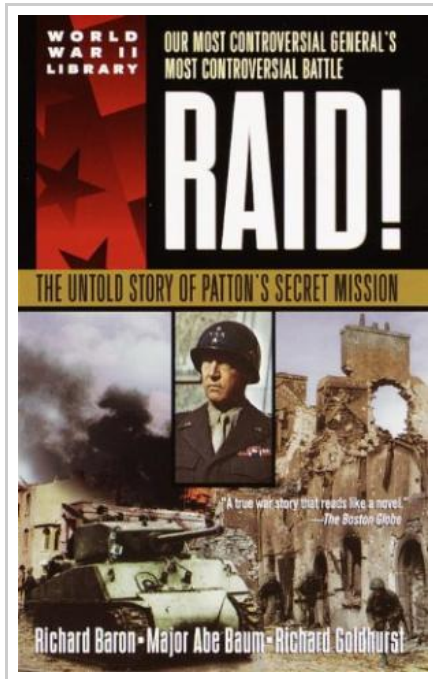




Raid!: The Untold Story of Patton's Secret Mission
