Since every sophisticated legal order furnishes a set of national business associations, traditionally parties, familiar with their own legal system, opted for one of those. However, the increase of cross-border commerce has broadened parties' and their legal advisors' perspective and has made them aware of the existence of alternative types of business associations under foreign law. At the same time, a gradual transition from the real seat theory to the incorporation theory in international company law facilitates the extraterritorial use of national business associations.
