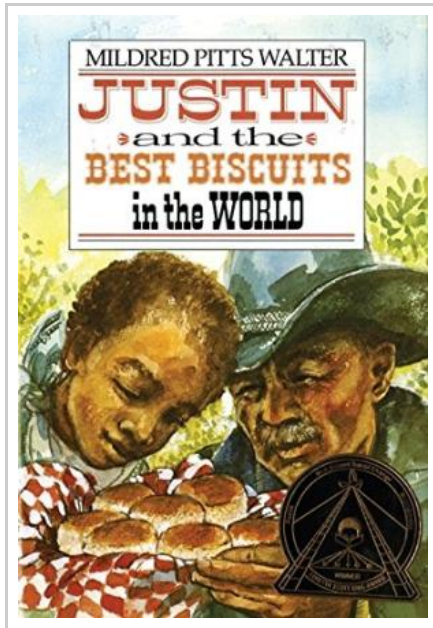




Justin and the Best Biscuits in the World (Hardback)
