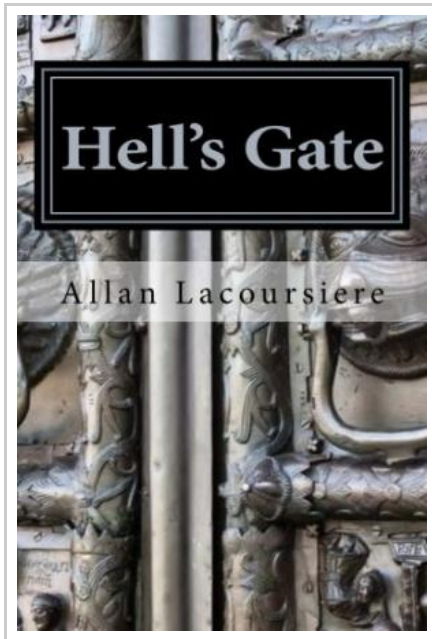




Hells Gate

Parallel beliefs existed throughout the centuries, beliefs carrying a warning to the unwary. Demons, some believed, could not leave Hell of their own volition, and instead must be summoned to our plane. These same games and ceremonies were seen by some as snares that corrupted and seduced the innocent, creating a portal through the Seals of Hell. Five kids from a small town stumble upon one such game in a Goth bible a cross between a ceremony and a drunken scavenger hunt. Throughout high school they dream of escaping small town life and finding enough players for the Grand Game, and when all five move to the big city to attend...



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
